Adopting FY 2015 FTA Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility Of Seniors
And Individuals With Disabilities Urbanized Funding Program of Projects
as Part of the Mobile Area Transportation Study**

WHEREAS, the Mobile Area Transportation Study (MATS) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by MAP-21 Sections 1201 and 1202, July, 2012); 42 USC 2000d, 7401; 49 USC 5303, 5304; 23 CFR Parts 450 and 500; 40 CFR Parts 51 and 93; and,

WHEREAS, The South Alabama Regional Planning Commission, on behalf of the Mobile Metropolitan Planning Organization, is the Urbanized Area Designated Recipient of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 funds consistent with 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 / MAP-21 Section 20009 for Enhanced Mobility Of Seniors And Individuals With Disabilities; and,


WHEREAS, 49 U.S.C. Section 5310 / MAP-21 Section 20009 allows public transportation projects that exceed the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) within the Mobile Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the Designated Recipient's process, consistent with Circular FTA C 9070.1G Enhanced Mobility Of Seniors And Individuals With Disabilities Program Guidance, created a Program of Projects (POP) identifying subrecipients for the Mobile Urbanized Area and projects for which the recipient is applying for financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, the projects listed in the attached Program of Projects are eligible for federal funding through FTA Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility Of Seniors And Individuals With Disabilities Urbanized Funding, and public comment on the proposed projects within the Program of Projects has been solicited for beyond the minimal requirements; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that after review, evaluation, and study, the MATS Metropolitan Planning Organization in session this 19th day of August, 2015, does hereby endorse and adopt the FY 2015 FTA Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility Of Seniors And Individuals With Disabilities Funding Program of Projects for the Mobile Urbanized Area as part of the Mobile Area Transportation Study.
