

RESOLUTION 18-014

**MOBILE AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (MATS)
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO)**

**Concurrence of the City of Mobile being the Mobile Urban Area
FTA Section 5307 and FTA Section 5339 Direct Recipient**

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has been delegated authority to award Federal financial assistance for public transportation as a transportation project; and

WHEREAS, the grant or cooperative agreement for Federal Financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the City of Mobile, and may require the City of Mobile to provide the local share of the said transportation project cost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mobile has provided all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration required for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mobile did adopt Resolution 60-300 on May 30th, 2005, authorizing the City of Mobile as the Direct Recipient of Federal Transit Administration Urbanized Area Formula Program authorized by 49 U.S. Code § 5307 - Urbanized area formula grants, and 49 U.S. Code § 5339 - Grants for buses and bus facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Mobile MPO did adopt Resolution 18-001 on December 13th, 2017 in error detailing the City of Mobile as the Designated Recipient, wherein the City of Mobile is actually the Direct Recipient of 49 U.S. Code § 5307 - Urbanized area formula grants, and 49 U.S. Code § 5339 - Grants for buses and bus facilities; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that after review and evaluation with coordination of local officials, the Wave Transit, and the Mobile Area Transportation Study Metropolitan Planning Organization in session this 11th day of July, 2018, Resolution 18-014 nullifies and replaces Mobile MPO Resolution 18-001 and does hereby concur with City of Mobile Resolution 60-300 authorizing the City of Mobile as the Direct Recipient of Federal Transit Administration Urbanized Area Formula Program as authorized by 49 U.S. Code § 5307 - Urbanized area formula grants and 49 U.S. Code § 5339 - Grants for buses and bus facilities.
