Purpose: As a recipient of US Department of Transportation (USDOT) financial assistance, the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is committed to promoting fairness and equity in Federally assisted programs and activities. The purpose of the informational sessions are to outline the basic Civil Rights responsibilities of all ALDOT sub-recipients (and future sub-recipients) of Federal financial assistance to include emphasis on ***Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program.***

Each session will provide a general overview of the 3 topics of discussion and their direct correlation with the public-at-large and the sub-recipient requirements. The sessions are aimed at educating all sub-recipients of Federal financial assistance through ALDOT, of their responsibility to use the funds in a nondiscriminatory manner.

Who Should Attend: Any administrative entity or person to whom federal assistance is indirectly extended either through ALDOT or another sub-recipient and whose conduct is subject to Title VI/nondiscrimination requirement and compliance obligations. Sub-recipients include, but are not limited to, metropolitan planning organizations, rural planning organizations, local government agencies, county engineers, city planners, ALDOT consultants, and colleges/universities.
