JOINT MOBILE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) POLICY BOARD/
TECHNICAL COORDINATING AND CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

The Mobile MPO Policy Board will meet on Wednesday, June 2nd, 2021 at 10:00. The meeting will be held at the GM&O Building located at 110 Beauregard Street, Mobile, AL 36602. There are several items on the agenda to review and adopt. The MPO will review and vote to adopt an amendment to the Envision 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan concerning Phase One of the I-10 Mobile River Bridge and Bayway Project. The Policy Board will also review and adopt the following changes to the 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

- Modify 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program to include:
 - STPAA, 5 Year Regional Traffic Operations (RTO) TSMO for 130 Signalized Intersections; \$1,632,160 & \$832,483
 - RALG (CN) - Adding Turn Lane To CR-27 (McCrary Road) Onto Access Road, Including Resurfacing And Extending The Existing Access Road, \$250,000; RACRNH Additional Lanes on I-10 from CR-39 to CR-59; Old Estimate \$40,238,400 to New Estimate: \$34,519,007
 - FTA 5310; Urban Program of Projects
 - HRRR; CN; Safety Improvements on Celeste Road from Janwood Court to Taylor Road; \$447,983
 - CRRSAA funding; PE and CN for each of the seven Municipalities CRRSAA; \$3,193,000
 - Phase One of the I-10 Mobile River Bridge; PE, \$44,500,000; CN \$665,000,000
 - Bicycle and Pedestrian Shared Use Paths Along SR-16 (US-90/Bay Bridge Road) from I-165 to East Cochrane Service Road PE; \$75,000; CN, \$7,000,000

Other agenda items include a review the DRAFT FY2022 Unified Planning Work Program.
