**JOINT MOBILE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) POLICY BOARD/
TECHNICAL COORDINATING AND CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING**

The Mobile MPO Policy Board will meet on Wednesday, August 19th, 2020 at 10:00 am via GOTOMEETING. The meeting link will be posted on www.mobilempo.org. The purpose of the meeting is to review and adopt FY 2021 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). The Unified Planning Work Program details the federally funded transportation planning activities to be undertaken in the Mobile Urban Area in FY 2020 by the Alabama DOT, the Wave Transit System, and the South Alabama Regional Planning Commission. The Draft FY2021 Unified Planning Work Program is available to review at www.mobilempo.org. Traditionally, the document is available at 43 locations around the Mobile Urban Area. However, due to concerns with the Covid-19/Coronavirus and many locations being closed to the public, the document is only available online. Also on the agenda, the Mobile MPO will review and adopt the following changes to the Transportation Improvement Program:

- Modify 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program
 - Cost estimate change for 100040584 (CN) US98, EB lanes from MS state line to .5 Mile East of Glenwood Rd, from \$18.2M to \$23.9M, FY 2022
 - Cost estimate change for 100033461 (CN) ADDL lanes on I-10 from CR-39 to Carol Plantation, from \$33.4M to \$41M, FY 2021
 - Add Project 100071946 (PE) 5 Year Regional Traffic Operations (RTOP) TSMO for 130 Signalized Intersections along SR-59, SR-16 (US-90), and SR-42 (US-98) in the Citites of Mobile, Spanish Fort, Daphne, Fairhope, Gulf Shores, and Foley; \$2,631,200; 8/1/2020
 - Add Project : 100072350 (PE) Independent Review Of Austal's Proposed Road Improvements On Dunlap Drive Over Wallace Tunnel And Bankhead Tunnel; \$170,000; 9/1/2020

Other agenda items include review and adopt an update of Performance Measure; approve the Financial Agreement with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation; review of the Demand Response Transit Study; and a discussion of potential Transportation Alternative Projects.
